



Amblecote attendance award criteria policy

At Amblecote it is the parents/guardians responsibility to ensure their child/children are at school, on time and in the correct uniform every day. As a school we endeavour to support and encourage this through our Attendance policy, newsletters, regular reminders in school and through our system of rewards.

This system of rewards is outlined below....

- Each week the class with the highest percentage attendance is given acknowledgment and a certificate on Friday, either in the Praise Assembly or in their classroom. That class has an extra 10 minutes playtime on that Friday afternoon or at a convenient time the following week.
- At the end of the Autumn term, in December, the children who have 100% attendance receive a bronze certificate and a star badge to wear.
- At the end of the Spring term, if these children continue with 100% attendance, they receive a silver certificate and star.
- At the end of the summer term they will receive a gold certificate and star, if attendance is again 100% and they also receive a £5 token from School.
- The first term a child manages 100% attendance they will receive the bronze certificate and star. This could be either spring or summer.
- If a child receives bronze in the spring they could achieve silver in the summer term.
- All attendance achievements are written in our bi monthly celebration newsletter.
- If a child only has one day off during a term they will receive acknowledgment and a sticker at the end of term Attendance Assembly.

- There are some allowances against 100% attendance which will still allow the award, they are as follows.....
 1. If a child is sent home from school once for illness during the term.
 2. If a child has a hospital appointment that cannot be changed. (Doctor or dentist appointments in school time do not count).
 3. If a child has a disability or medical illness that requires regular hospital appointments during a term.
