In Dudley children start primary school the September after their 4th birthday. The law states all children must start school by the beginning of the term after their 5th birthday.

Please note it is not first come, first served. Dudley Local Authority recommends that you apply online. Applying online means you will receive your decision via email after 2pm on the offer date.

If you are experiencing difficulties or prefer to make a paper application please contact the school admissions service. Paper applications will not be available until 1 October 2018. Please be aware that if you make a paper application, your decision will be posted 2nd class on the offer date.

- Return date for paper application forms 15 January 2019 by 5pm*
- Return date for online applications 15 January 2019 by midnight*
- Decision emails to parents 16 April 2019 after 2pm

- Appeals to be heard June/July 2019

* Failure to return your form/apply by this date may affect the outcome of your application. Attendance at a nursery attached to a primary school will not guarantee admission to that particular primary school or give any advantage to the pupil in the admissions process.
