In RE we will be focusing on the theme of 'Caring for others'.

In PHSE we will be exploring the topic 'It's my body' and thinking about ways in which we can keep our bodies happy and healthy.

In Maths the children will continue to work on number, calculations, shape, money and measures.

Through RM unify the children can access their own independent maths activities using **RM Easimaths**. They can use their own log in to access this. To help with times tables the children can access TTRockstars. In addition to this you can help by:

- Learning number bonds to 10 and 20 (+ and -) e.g. 4 + 6 = 10
- Reading, writing and ordering 2 digit numbers.
- Finding 1 more and 1 less and 10 more and 10 less.
- Use two dice and add the numbers together.
- Playing dominoes adding spots, finding doubles.
- Adding coins when out shopping 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p.
- Try counting in twos, threes, fives and tens!
- Practising 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Practising the skill of subtracting.
- Partitioning 2 digit numbers.

We will continue to work on our letter


formation and punctuating sentences with a capital letter and a full stop. We will look at how to use a conjunction such as 'and' to join our ideas and sentences.

We will be practising our skills of using a capital letters for names of people, places, the days of the week and the personal pronoun I as well as using an exclamation mark and a question mark correctly in our writing. We will then use our skills for retelling stories, writing diary entries, letters, in the role of different characters and instructions.

• Encouraging your child to talk about the stories - What is their favourite part? Who is their favourite character and why? Can they retell the story by using the pictures!







To help with **reading** and **writing**:

- Write stories, lists or birthday cards together.
- Practise correct letter formation remembering the kinetic letters' techniques.
- Continue to practise reading and writing the common exception words.
