

WELCOME

We are now looking forward to an exciting half term with our theme being "Festivals and Celebrations". This week we will talk about bonfires, fireworks and Diwali celebrations. The children will produce firework and Diwali pictures for our display.

Children have started to move their bodies to the music and practice movements to support upper body strength. This is vital to early writing and when using the Kinetic Letters programme that your child will follow along their journey in the Early year's foundation stage.

We are encouraging the children to find their own coat and to try and put them on. We are also encouraging them to find their own name card. Parents can help with this on arrival. We are also asking the children to look after the environment by tidying away toys they have finished with and playing with toys nicely.

Please feel free to collect a 'WOW' moment from the Parents Notice Board that is located as you walk into T4T's. These can be completed at home, celebrated in session and then put on the British values display. Holiday snapshots and general photographs can be emailed to the setting and added to children's online learning journey. Your child is encouraged to talk about the photographs to support Communication and Language skills.

HOW CAN I BE HELPED AT HOME TO CONTINUE MY LEARNING?

- **Physical Development Moving and handling** • Play ball games with me. • Give me lots of ribbons that I can wave around me. • Let me try and dress my teddy or doll with different types of clothes, like coats, jumpers and dresses, and different types of fastenings, like buttons, Velcro and zips. **Health and self-care** • Let me help get lunch ready, encourage hand washing and toilet training routine.
- **Communication and Language Listening and attention** • Use sock puppets or animals when you're sharing one of my favourite stories or songs with me. **Understanding** • When we're making a sandwich together tell me what you are doing so I know what to do. **Speaking** • When we're playing with things, use new words to describe what I'm doing with them or to tell me what they are called
- **Personal, Social and Emotional Development Making relationships** • Make dens from sheets and blankets that I can play in with you or my friends. **Self-confidence and self-awareness** • Make a box with different things in it, like glue and different types of paper, that I can choose from when I'm making a picture or model from boxes. **Managing feelings and behaviour** • Talk to me about the order I need to do things in, like brushing my teeth or getting ready for bed.



DAYS OUT BEAR

'Billy Bear', the Days out Bear, has enjoyed the adventures he has so far been on. Children can take 'Billy Bear' on an exciting day trip or a holiday; a photo and a short explanation can be noted on the sheet provided. When the bear is returned to T4T's your child is encouraged to talk about their adventure with Billy Bear.

REMINDERS

- Can we ask that only **one** parent/carer comes into T4T's to sign out their child so as to ensure the safety of children when we hand them over at the end of a session.
- Remember to keep checking your children for nits and head lice. If any lice are found live in children's hair, the child will be sent home until treated.
- A weekly activity sheet is displayed on the T4T's window that will inform you of the proposed activities for the week; this will include any special events, home links, visitors and the Rhyme and story of the week.
- If you are paying additional fees to T4T's can parents please be reminded to send correct monies or cheques payable to "Amblecote Primary School" in a sealed envelope with the child's name and the weeks you are paying for. The fee's need to be either paid for weekly, monthly or half termly.
- Children should come to T4T's dressed in practical clothing. Children will spend some of the session outside also. Please can we ask for a pair of wellies to be kept here so children can access the outdoor area as and when they want to. Can parents also make sure children have a weather appropriate coat every day. Thank you.
