## Knowledge

### Pronunciation:

#### The grapheme oi

In English, the grapheme 'oi' is pronounced as in oil, boil and soil. In French, it is pronounced as in poisson, bois, trois and étoile.

### Grammar:

#### Gender:

In French, nouns are divided into 2 categories: **masculine and feminine**. In French, all nouns have a gender. In English nouns do not have a grammatical gender.

#### Verb:

**A verb** expresses an action or a state of being. It describes what is happening. It is sometimes called a 'doing word' because it describes what someone does.

#### Pronoun:

**A pronoun** can replace a noun. English subject pronouns include I, you, he, she, it, we and they. The French pronoun je is the equivalent of the English pronoun I.

#### Cognate:

**A cognate** is a word in one language that is related in origin to a word in another language.
