- How to create a leaflet to help someone search for information on the Internet.

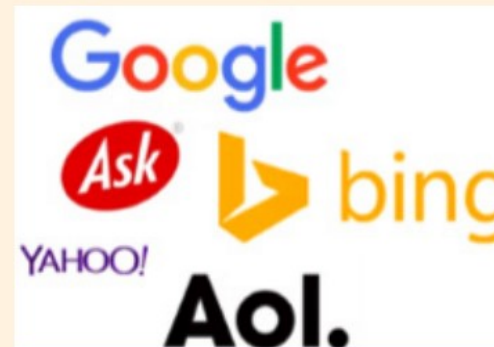
Knowledge
