Calm- To be quiet and not show any excitement.

Listen- to use your ears to pay attention to something.

Look- To turn your eyes towards something so that you can see it.

Quiet- To not make a noise.

Still- To stay in one position without moving.

- Talk about what each word means.
- Can your child use these words correctly in a sentence?
