It's Math's Week in Pre-school this week, we will also be talking to the children about Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.

Children had a fantastic Muddy Monday yesterday, we used hoops, balls, bats and balls on the field. We explored the mobile playground, climbing on equipment and painting, we then played in the Builder's Yard and splatter painted Bonfire Night pictures.

We ate toast for snack and swept up autumn leaves and built a bonfire using blocks and planks and hot colour material.



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Word Ninja of the Day

<u>girl</u>- a female child -someone who helps others to learn new things

<u>home</u>-a place where you live <u>stop</u>-to end what you are doing <u>quiet</u>- to make little or no noise

Talk about what these words mean. Can your child use these words correctly in a sentence? Help them by modelling a sentence for them.

Poem of the Week-Fireworks Go

Say this poem with your child, encourage your child to join in.

"Whizz-bang,
There goes another one,
It's such tremendous fun
Fireworks go up and down,
And round and round"

Colour of the Week: purple

Shape of the Week: triangle (3 sides and 3

corners)

Story of the Week: Dear Zoo Rhyme of the Week: Firework Number Rhyme (see attached sheet)



Phonics

This will encourage your child to listen carefully as they search for an object. You will need a kitchen timer or a small clock or a mobile phone.

What you need to do:

- 1. sit together in a quiet place.
- 2. Show the children what is going to make the sound and how it works. Listen with your child to the sound it makes.
 - 3. Listen to other sounds you can hear in the room.
 - 4. Hide the sound maker in the room and then help your child to listen for the sound then hunt for it.
 - 5. Keep encouraging your child to stop and listen-what can they hear? You can also play this game outside but you may need a louder sound.
