Phonics

- Try to read to your child every day. It's a special time to snuggle up and enjoy a story. Stories matter and children love re-reading them and looking over the pictures. Try adding funny voices to bring characters to life.
- You could try cooking a recipe you've read together. Alternatively, play a game where you pretend to be the characters in a book, or discuss an interesting article you've read.

Mathematics

Find objects that go together. If your child has difficulty with one-to-one correspondence, find objects that correlate—such as spoons and forks, cups and saucers—and ask your child to pair them together. As they do, have them count each set of objects to help reinforce the idea that each pair consists of the same number.

Take a picture of what you find and send it to the class DOJO.
