There will be no Muddy Monday on the 23rd May due to the Queens Jubilee celebrations in school happening that week, you will be informed about what will be happening at the end of next week.


We are closed on Monday and Thursday.

Phonics Activities

In Pre-school we are now beginning to segment and blend CVC words for the children who are going to be transferring into the Reception class. Please see the attached to sheet for this activity.

Children who will be remaining in Pre-school may like to try this activity:

Take your child on a listening walk. Walk around the park or stand

outside in the garden and listen out for sounds. Your child can then report back on what they have heard. Alternatively, ask your child to close their eyes and listen for one minute while inside. They can then tell you then the sounds they have heard, e.g. shoes shuffling, traffic noise, clock ticking.





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<u>Mathematics</u>

Recite numbers to 5 with your child on a daily basis (school readiness).



When counting objects say one number for each object,

encouraging your child to point to them accurately.

Use fingers to represent numbers e.g. holding up 1 finger to represent number 1, 2 fingers to represent number 2 etc.
