Phonics Activities

In Pre-school we are continuing to segment and blend CVC words for the children who are going to be transferring into the Reception class.

See the attached Phonics 1 wk2 sheet.

For children who are remaining in Pre-school they can practice the sounds of the letters in their name,

Parents can write the child's name on a piece of paper pointing to each letter and saying the sound with their child.

Ordering Numbers to 5

Find numbers 1-5 from around the home, these can be magnets, flash cards or even written numbers, encourage your child to put them in the correct order, this can be extended to 10.
