



Sports Premium

The sports premium is specific funding designed to improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. Amblecote Primary has received £14,656 funding to improve the provision of physical education throughout Amblecote.

The provision we have is already good. Children are taught PE weekly following the Dudley Policy into Practice schemes of work which ensure a range of themes are taught throughout each year including dance, gymnastics, sports and athletics involving a wide range of skills which are developmental and progressive from Reception to Year 6.

We teach swimming throughout Years 3 and 4 to ensure the children have the ability to swim well which is a life saving skill.

We offer a variety of extra curriculum opportunities which involve physical education such as Fitness Stars, football, netball, dance, skipping, dodgeball, multi skills and gymnastics.

The premium money has been used to offer numerous in school taster sessions for physical education activities to encourage the children to participate in physical activity. These include golf, archery, cheer leading, hoola hooping, curling and zumba. There will be more in the future.

Also we develop the knowledge and skills of all the class teachers by using skilled coaches to teach the children while the teachers observe and learn.

Some of the funding has been used to give our PE co-ordinator time to plan, organise and develop our PE provision and promote more competitive sport at Amblecote. The Sports Premium will pay for Tops cards to develop skills in PE lessons.

We also use the money to support our participation in the Stourbridge network schools sports provision, such as coaches and equipment, so we participate in the Dell athletics sporting event and cross country running and we co-operate with and participate in our local secondary schools sporting provision. We also subscribe to the Youth Trust who support & our provide sports provision.

Future developments will include:

- More provision for our gifted and talented pupils.
- Improved resources to effectively teach a wide range of skills to all our pupils.
- More competitive sport at Amblecote.
- Coach costs to participate in future events at designated sporting venues.
- Further CPD for staff
