What did Jack find at the top of the Beanstalk?

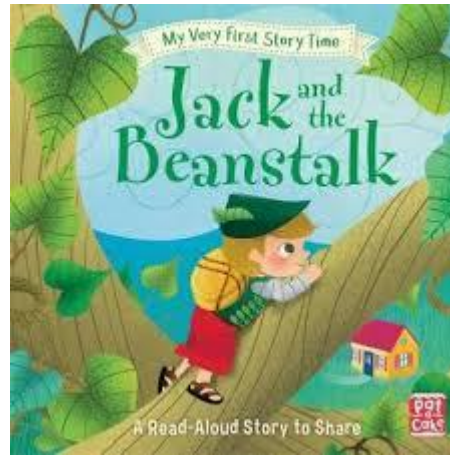
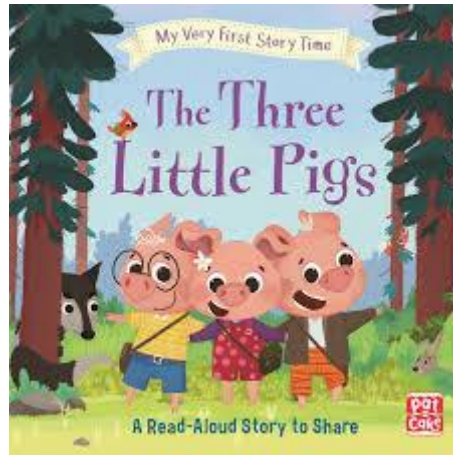
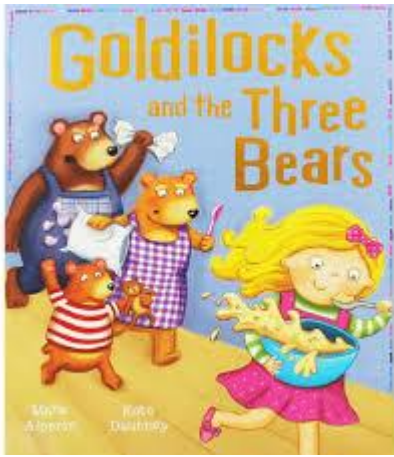

### Name the Story
