

Pupil Friendly Child Protection Policy

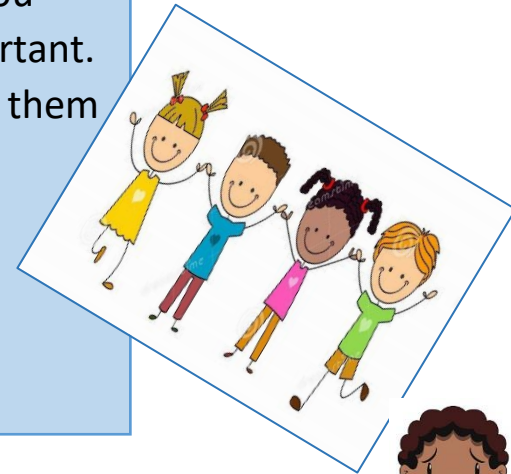


What is child protection about?
